Dress and Equipment

Friday and Saturday morning will consist of lectures, and therefore, dress is whatever is comfortable for you. Starting Saturday afternoon, we will begin the live fire portion of the course. Please dress according to the weather, as we will be outside 8-9 hours daily, depending on range applications. Conditions can include dust, mud, rain, snow, wind, and extremes of temperature. Check the local Youngstown forecast prior to departure, and pack dress appropriate to weather conditions.

Recommended clothing items to have on hand are listed below:

- Hiking type boots
- Rain gear
- Cold weather clothing
- Gloves
- Cap or Toque
- Hat (for sun protection)
- Water bottle
- Day pack
- NO shorts or sandals are permitted during live fire training.

Equipment needed while on course:

- Precision rifle capable of shooting 1 MOA or better and equipped with a bipod.
- 200 rounds of match grade ammo (must be same type and weight). If attending course with reloaded ammo, the rounds MUST be loaded with the same projectile, casing, power, and primer. This is to ensure consistency during range applications.
- Optics with tactical type adjustable turrets, in either MOA or Mils.
- Anti-can't bubble level, or equivalent, mounted to your system.
- Shooting mat of some sort (RFMA has limited number of mats that students are welcome to use)
- Spotting scope with tripod (RFMA has limited number of spotters that students are welcome to use)
- Small calculator (students typically use their smart phones)
- Shooting bag / shooting sock (RFMA has limited number of shooting bags that students are welcome to use)
- Writing material (pencil, pens & paper)
- Cleaning supplies for your rifle
- Tools for your rifle & optic system
- Hearing & eye protection
